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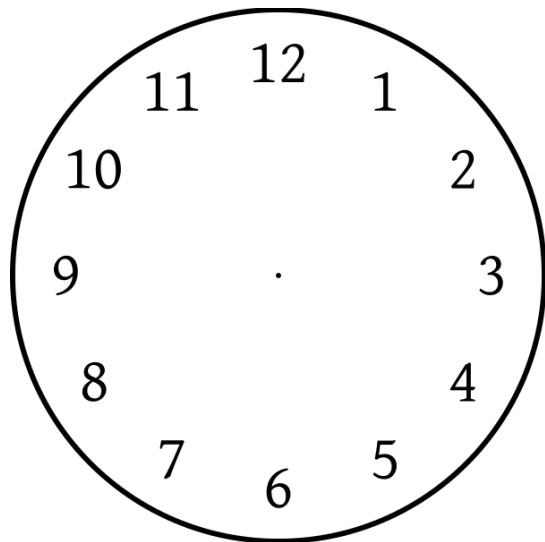
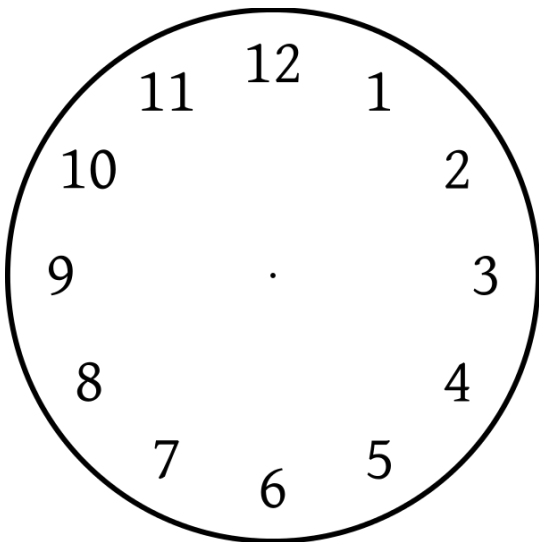
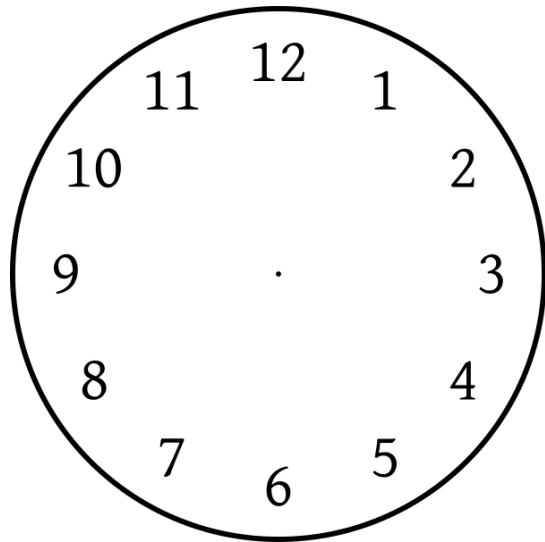
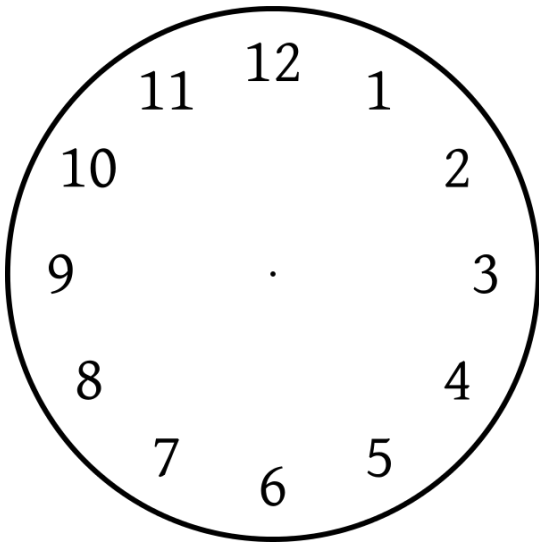
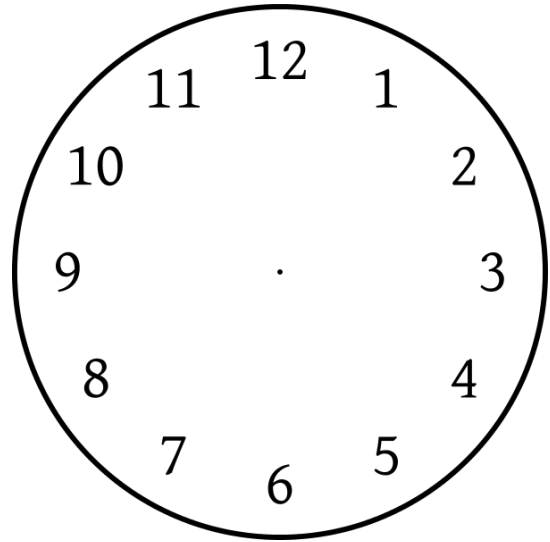
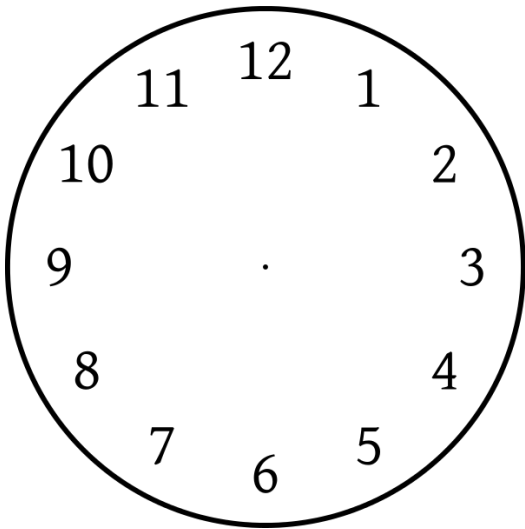
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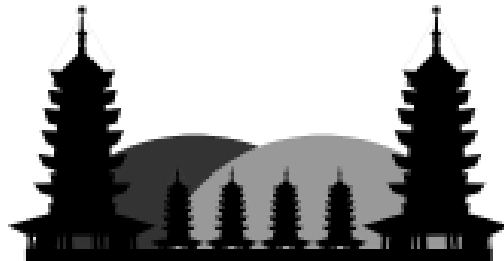
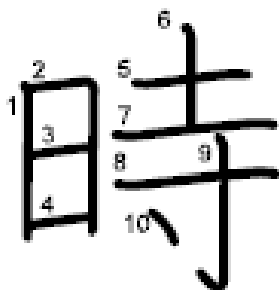
Writing "o' clock" or "hour"

日 means SUN/ DAY and 寺 means TEMPLE

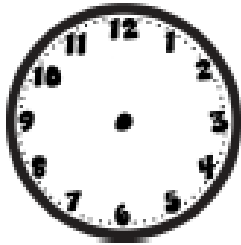
Apparently in olden times, during the DAY, people were alerted of the TIME by a gong or bell being struck at a TEMPLE.



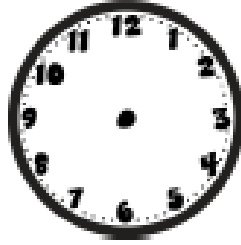

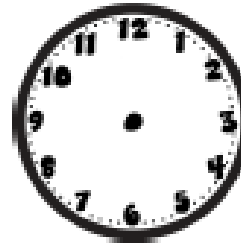
Draw the times shown on the clocks. Big hand: red. Small hand: blue.



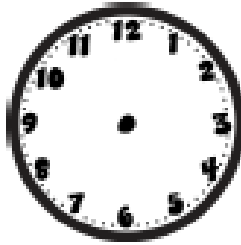
